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## Visit to Granada:

Founded in 1524 by Spanish conquistador Francisco Hernández de Córdoba, Granada is the oldest city of the Americas on firm land. Prior to being colonized by the Spanish and becoming an important trade route, Granada was the site of bustling indigenous communities. Various exhibits at the Iglesia y Convento San Francisco "Granada's Convent-Church of San Francisco: A Must-See Museum" (NicaNews 17) give a glimpse of pre-Columbian indigenous life in the area.

- a) Tour in a private boat in lake Nicaragua around part of the 357 little islands that were form during the eruption of the mombacho volcano.
- b) Las Isletas is a group of more than 300 islands —many inhabited by humans and all inhabited by our fine-feathered friends— just off the shores of Granada. These islands were formed ten thousand years ago by the explosion of Volcán Mombacho. A wonderful way to spend the day is to tour one or more of the islands, catching glimpses of traditional fishing village life, and birds aplenty, along the way.
- c) Tour around the most important colonial style builings in Granada and history given by our Tour guide.



## Lunch in Masaya city at the "Che Gris Restaurant".

Masaya, Masaya is nestled between the Meseta de los Pueblos and Masaya Lagoon (laguna). The city is also very near the still-active volcano of the same name. The historical downtown market, now host to a tourist-centered handicrafts (artesanía) market, rounds out the tourist attractions for the area.

- a) Visit to the Handicraft Market of Masaya; in a central plaza framed by impressive old stone walls. Today, the wares on offer range from truly fine handicrafts, particularly the famous Masaya hammocks, to tacky Made-in-China tourist souvenirs, and everything in between. There are also handicrafts such as masks from the different popular performances (e.g., the Gueguense), etc..
- b) Visit to the crater of an inactive volcano located in an indigenous village named Santa Catarina.
